Admission includes:

- A guided tour of the Overholt family homestead, the summer kitchen, carriage house and Springhouse which is the birthplace of Henry Clay Frick.
- An introductory video that provides an overview of West Overton Village and information on the distilling operation that existed at West Overton and the process of turning coal into coke, a by-product of steel.
- A self-guided tour of the museum, located in the distillery building. Many items from the Overholt and Frick era are located in the museum which includes whiskey cases, farm equipment and the chair that Henry Clay Frick was seated in when Alexander Berkman made an assassination attempt on his life.
- An opportunity to tour the stock barn and the brick barn which is the largest brick barn in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- A tour of the West Overton Gardens including the flower garden and herb gardens.
- A sampling of our signature West Overton Teas.
